The deadline for submissions is Friday, March 16, 2012. The GeoEducation Subcommittee makes the final selection and the award is presented to the recipient at the annual Delaware GIS Conference, which will be held on Thursday, April 26, 2012 at the Sheraton Dover Hotel in Dover, DE.

#### **Eligibility:**

All K-12 teachers and administrators in Delaware schools are eligible. Also eligible are student group advisors and leaders of community groups for children.
