

Creating a Presentation From a Map

Log into your Delaware GeoEducation Org account.

A presentation is most effective when the map you are sharing has multiple layers. This is a quick and easy way to walk someone else through data.

First, obtain (or create) a map with multiple layers of data.

- Go to the **Groups** page.
- Open the **Workshop Group Exercise** group.
- Open the map named **ConnectED Colleges and Universities**.
- Click "**Create Presentation**" in the top right corner of the page to open the Presentation Editing Screen shown below.



- Click the **+Add** button to create a new slide.
 - Provide a slide title - this is the only text available.
 - Set a location by first moving the map to the desired location then click the **Set To Current** button.
 - Check off all the layers you would like shown on this slide.
 - Select the desired basemap.
 - Click Slide List to add the slide to the presentation.
 - Continue this process to add all the desired slides.
- Click the **Save** button to save the presentation.
- Click **Play** to preview the presentation.

To open the presentation at a later date:

- Go to My Content
- Select the drop-down arrow to the right of the map name and select Open Presentation.
